CERTIFICATE III IN HEALTH SERVICE ASSISTANCE HLT32507

This course is designed for participants who want to work in roles that provide assistance to health professional staff with the care of clients and involves the worker in direct client contact under supervision.

Participants will learn skills and techniques to provide a range of health support activities as well as undertake specific work functions in operating theatre support and assisting in nursing work in acute care. In addition this qualification supports multi-skilling requirements of smaller and rural/remote work settings.

Participants who successfully complete the course will gain a nationally recognised HLT32507 Certificate III in Health Service Assistance.
